Art, Essay, and Photography Contest- Submission Rules

A valid submission will contain the following information:

1. Artwork, Essay, or Photograph.
 - Each must be original, authentic, unpublished, the sole property and work of the entrant.
 - Each entry must conform to age group and dimensions as specified below.
2. Contact information and description as outlined below.

First and last name

School and Teacher (if applicable)

School Address with zip code (or personal address if not submitting through a school)

Teacher E-mail address

For Art and Photography entries: supply a one- to two-sentence description explaining your entry.

3. A completed **and signed** entry form. Print out the entry form and submit it with your entry.

Entries cannot be accepted without a signed entry form (supplied).

***For photography entries: If a person under 18 appears in the photograph, the parental consent line on the entry form must be signed by the child's parent or guardian.**

Format Rules:

***Art Entry: Grades K-5 only**

Artwork dimensions: 2 dimensional (flat) project no larger than 8 ½ inches x 14 inches.

***Essay entry: Grades 6-9 only**

Essay length: Typed essay of no more than 300 words.

***Photography Entry: All ages**

Photograph no larger than 8 ½ inches by 11 inches.

DEADLINE: All entries must be postmarked by September 30, 2010.

•Winners will be notified via teacher or personalemail address and/ or phone number.

•Please include a brief memo with School and Teacher contact information and specify whether you would like entries to be returned to you at the completion of the contest.
