A valid submission **MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING**:

- **1.Original, Unpublished** Artwork, Essay, or Photograph.
 - Each must be <u>original</u>, <u>authentic</u>, <u>unpublished</u>, <u>the sole property and work of the entrant</u>. Copy written or reproduced material from the internet (including social media) may not be used.
 - Each entry must conform to age group and dimensions as specified below.
